Rules for Kempston Gardens of Rest

These rules concerning the maintenance of Gardens of Rest were approved by the Kempston Burials Joint Committee on 14 December 2015.

1. Bases, fencing and kerbs **are not permitted** under any circumstances.
2. The scattering of chippings and the planting of shrubs, roses and flowers is not permitted.
3. Bronze plaques on the walls are available for both the interment of ashes and the 'scattering' of ashes provided the rights to place a plaque have been purchased. Plaques must not exceed 225mm in length and 110mm in width.
4. Memorial vases are only allowed when ashes have been interred and not 'scattered'. Rights to place a vase must be purchased and vases must not exceed 150mm in height. All vases and flowers are to be kept within the allocated space of 12" (width) per plot. Please note that this may not correspond with the layout of the paving slabs.
5. Stone tablets/books with inscriptions are allowed provided the rights to place such items have been purchased. These must not exceed 430mm in length and 330mm in width.
6. No flowers or other items are to be placed on the grass.
7. No other items or mementos must be placed in the Garden of Rest. Any items will be removed by cemetery staff without further consultation.
